

# JOHN W. SITARZ '65

Jack was a three-year starter on the Varsity Football, Basketball and Baseball teams; he was class president and captain of the basketball team as a junior and senior; and captain of the baseball team as a senior. During junior year, he scored 35 points in a single game, tying the school record, and in senior year ranked second in all-time scoring and was named All-State. He received the Anthony Prize, the Irving Prize, the Williams Club of Hartford Prize, the Class of 1958 Award, and the William R. MacDonald Prize for the outstanding athlete in the senior class. Frosty Francis said he was “the most complete player he had ever coached.” At Wesleyan, Jack started on the basketball and baseball teams all four years. And, in 1970, he played baseball for a Boston Red Sox Minor League team. A partner at the law firm of Cooney, Scully and Dowling, Jack and his wife Margaret live in West Hartford, CT and have 3 daughters: Julia Sitarz Lasek, Mary Kate Sitarz, and Jane Sitarz.
