Bob received six varsity letters while at Kingswood. He was the captain of the ski team, a two-time Connecticut State Junior Champion in skiing and President of the Outing Club. Bob represented the Eastern United States in the Junior National Ski Championships in Reno, NV. Bob also received six varsity letters and was the captain of the ski team while attending Williams. He was named to the World Championship Nordic Ski Squad in 1954. Bob's post graduate accomplishments include: 1955 University of Oslo Slalom Champion, 1955 Heming Idrettslaget Combined Champion, 1956 Swiss University Combined Champion, 1956 Olympic Nordic Ski Squad, 1960 Member US Nordic Olympic Ski Squad. He was also the manager for the US Nordic Olympic and the US Nordic World Championship (FIS) Ski Teams in 1964 and 1966 respectively. Bob was the Assistant Chief Steward for the 1980 Winter Olympic Games in Lake Placid. Bob also served as a Senior Faculty Executive for Ski Mechanics and Managers Workshops -North America from 1981-2001.
