In addition, John was a member of the varsity soccer team during his sophomore and junior years. While at the United States Military Academy, John played Division I varsity hockey during the two years he was there. He continued on to play varsity hockey at Williams College during his junior and senior years. John was named the MVP his senior year and was an honorable mention for the ECAC.
