At K-O, Joey played varsity soccer and lacrosse for four years and varsity ice hockey for six years. She was captain of ice hockey for four years and captain of the soccer and lacrosse teams her senior year.

Joey was MVP of ice hockey for four years and MVP of all three sports her senior year. In lacrosse, she was an All-American her junior and senior years.

She was a member of the All New England lacrosse team that played at the national tournament her junior and senior years.

Joey received the Robert Lazear Award for her competitive spirit and dedication to K-O athletics.

She went on to compete for four years on the varsity ice hockey and lacrosse teams at Harvard University. She was captain of the ice hockey team her junior and senior years and MVP her freshman, junior and senior years. She also was academic All-Ivy League her senior year at Harvard.

In lacrosse at Harvard, she competed in the Division I NCAA championships.
