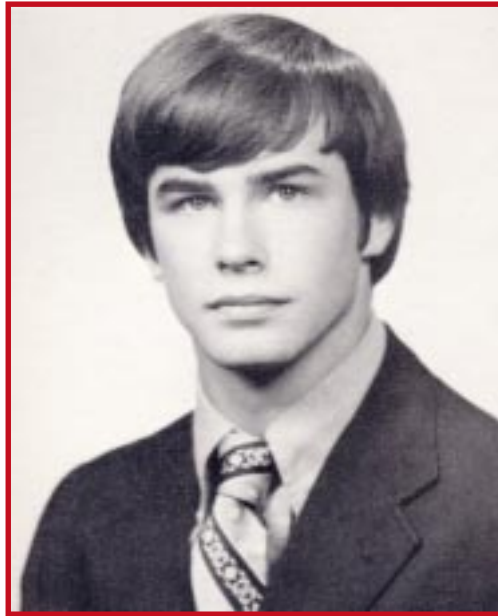


JEFFREY L. HICKEY, CLASS OF 1975



At K-O, Jeff was captain of the football, basketball and lacrosse teams his senior year. He also was the recipient of the Connecticut Valley Lacrosse award in 1974 and 1975.

Also in 1975, Jeff won the William R. MacDonald Prize, given to that student who has proved himself an outstanding male athlete and who best exemplifies diligence in practice, sportsmanship and spirit of competition.

He was named to two high school All-American rosters and was MVP of the KIT tournament his senior year. Jeff was All-Western New England and All-American in lacrosse.

At Dartmouth, he was a star athlete, playing football and lacrosse. He is the leading goal scorer in the history of Dartmouth lacrosse. He also was the nation's leading Division I scorer his senior year. Jeff was honored in Sports Illustrated's "Faces in the Crowd" for setting the NCAA consecutive goals scored record in college lacrosse.

On the football field, he was MVP of the varsity team his junior year and an All-Ivy League linebacker his senior year on the Ivy League Championship team.
