

## JOSEPH J. NASTRI, CLASS OF 1975



At K-O, Joe earned nine varsity letters. He also was co-captain of the football, basketball and lacrosse teams. During his senior year, the basketball team won the KIT.

In 1974, Joe (along with Kevin Tyler) was honored in Sports Illustrated's "Faces in the Crowd" for his success in running the ball for more than 1,000 yards in eight games.

Joe was the recipient of the William R. MacDonald Prize, given to that student who has proved himself an outstanding male athlete and who best exemplifies diligence in practice, sportsmanship and spirit of competition.

He went on to be an outstanding athlete at Dartmouth, where he earned seven varsity letters. He was captain of the freshman and varsity football teams. During his senior year, he was named First Team All-Ivy League at linebacker and Honorable Mention All-East at linebacker, helping his team win the Ivy League championship. He was named Chevrolet Defensive Player of the Game for the nationally televised contest against Princeton.

While at Dartmouth, Joe also played lacrosse, and he was a four-year starter at midfield and defense. His senior year, he was named Second Team All-Ivy League and All-New England at defense. He also won the Tom Dent MVP Award during his senior season.
