

Head Varsity Boys Lacrosse Coach

General Statement of Responsibility

The head coach will report to the Director of Athletics and collaborate with all program stakeholders: assistant coaches, student-athletes, faculty/staff, and parents. The position manages all aspects of a competitive varsity lacrosse program striving for NEPSAC excellence.

Duties:

- Direct coaching responsibilities inclusive of: program organization (MS, JV, and Varsity), practice planning, game preparation/management, and overall student-athlete development following Kingswood Oxford's mission statement and core values.
 - Support KO commitment to student-athletes through prioritization of student academic success, character development, and involvement with the campus community at-large.
 - Work with the admissions department to recruit highly skilled and mission appropriate student-athletes to KO.
 - Counsel and provide guidance to student-athletes engaged in the NCAA recruitment process.
 - Foster program cohesion grades 6-12.
 - Administrative tasks including but not limited to: constant and continuous communication with athletic department, prepare and update team rosters, oversee individual and team stats, provide game wrap ups to media outlets and KO website, attend league and conference meetings for FAA and NEPSAC.
 - Provide end of season duties such as collection of information, uniforms, award winners, and season review.
 - Create a competitive, fun, and positive environment for all student-athletes.
 - Other duties as assigned by the Director of Athletics.
